GENDER PAY GAP REPORT

LEGISLATION INTRODUCED IN APRIL 2017 REQUIRES ANY ORGANISATION WITH MORE THAN 250 EMPLOYEES TO PUBLISH THEIR GENDER PAY GAP.

WHAT IS THE GENDER PAY GAP

The gender pay gap is the measure of the difference in the average earnings of men and woman across an organisation regardless of specific job.

Gender pay gap reporting focuses on 4 main areas:

- Hourly paid gap mean and median
- Bonus pay gap mean and median
- Proportion of men and woman receiving bonus pay
- Proportion of men and woman in different pay quartiles

Tillicoultry Quarries statistics are based on the snap shot data take from our payroll as of 5th April 2023.

All employees receiving less than full pay (for example sick pay) on the snapshot date of 5th April 2023 were excluded from these calculations.

OUR WORKFORCE

In our Tillicoultry Quarries Business we had employees as of 5th April 2023. We had 324 employees in total, 27 woman and 297 men.




PROPORTION OF MALES AND FEMALES IN EACH PAY QUARTILE
