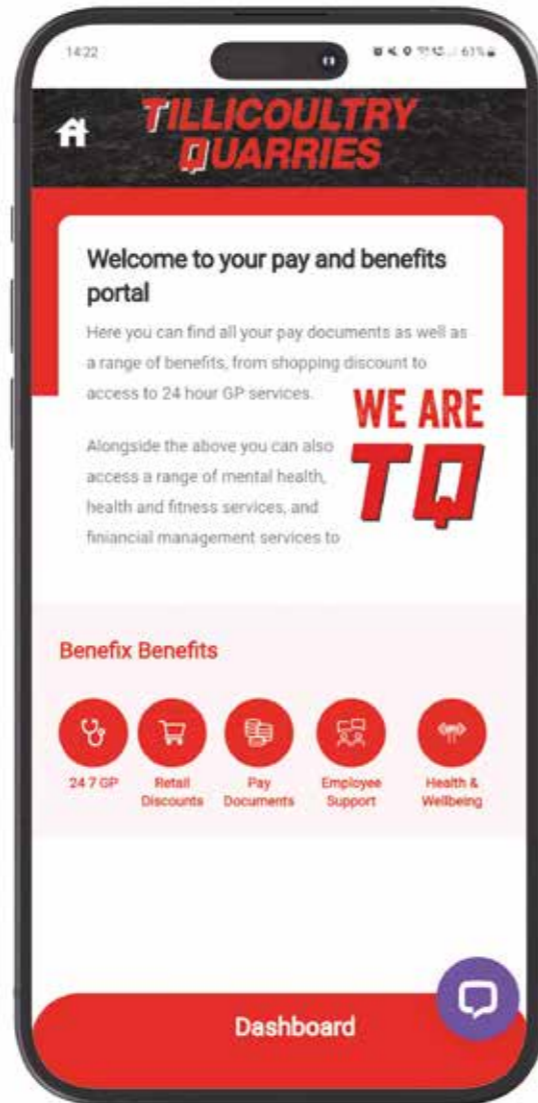

Suggestion: Install a gantry at the wash bay. This addition would facilitate safe access to the top of the mobile plant without the need to climb with the lance. By reducing the risk of injury associated with climbing, and improving the thoroughness of window cleaning, the gantry would enhance both safety and visibility. It is proposed to place a large gantry on the concrete pad at the back, ensuring that there is still sufficient space for vehicle movement.

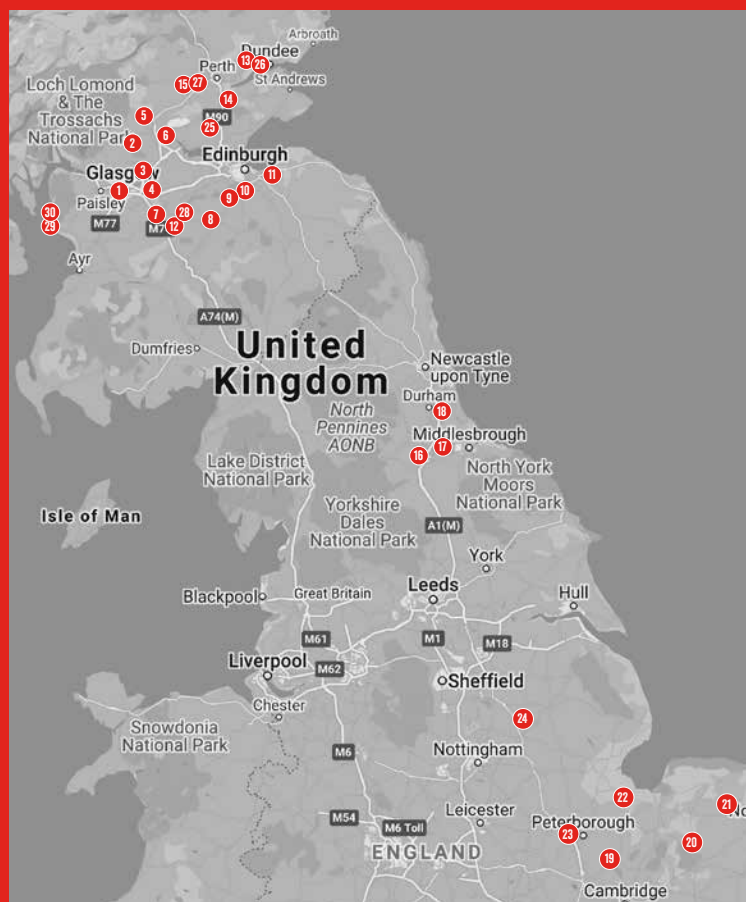
